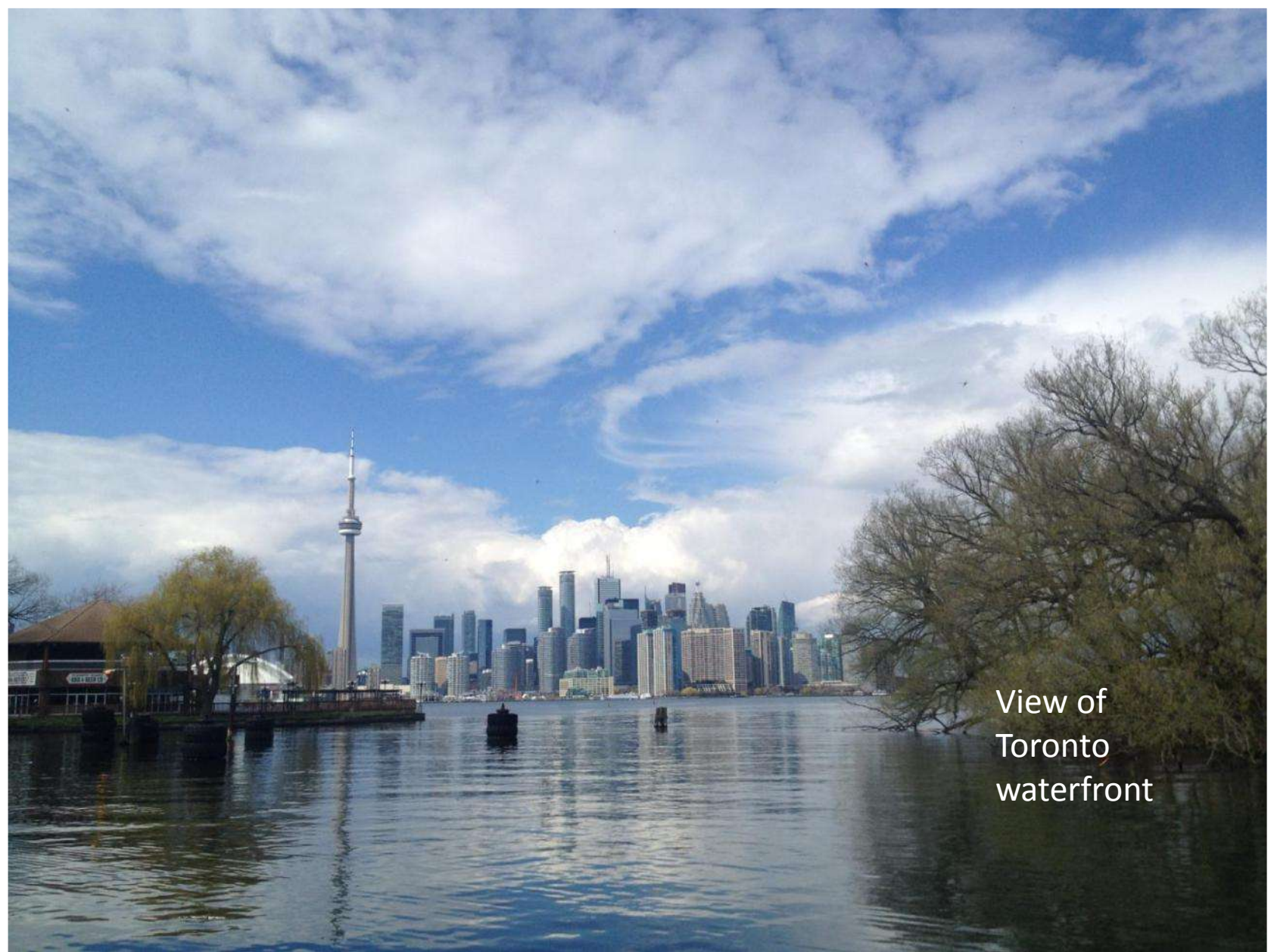

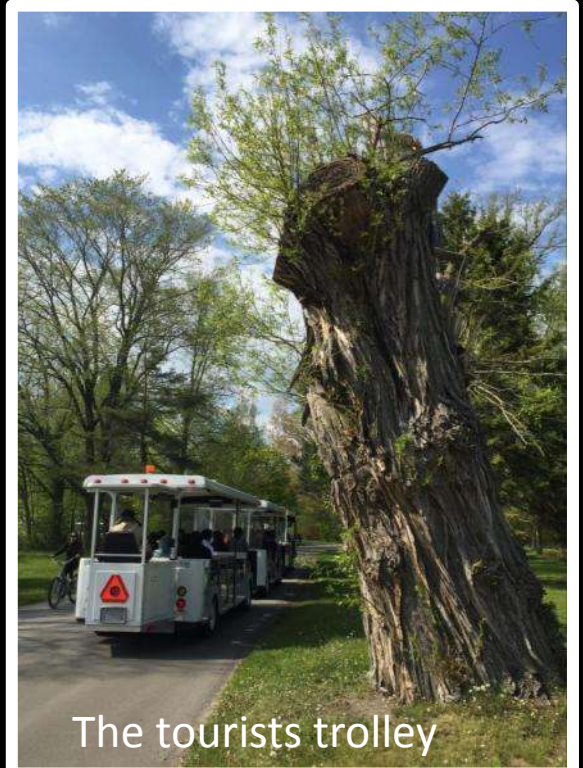


The pier looks very different from the days of my last visit to Centre Island in the early 90's

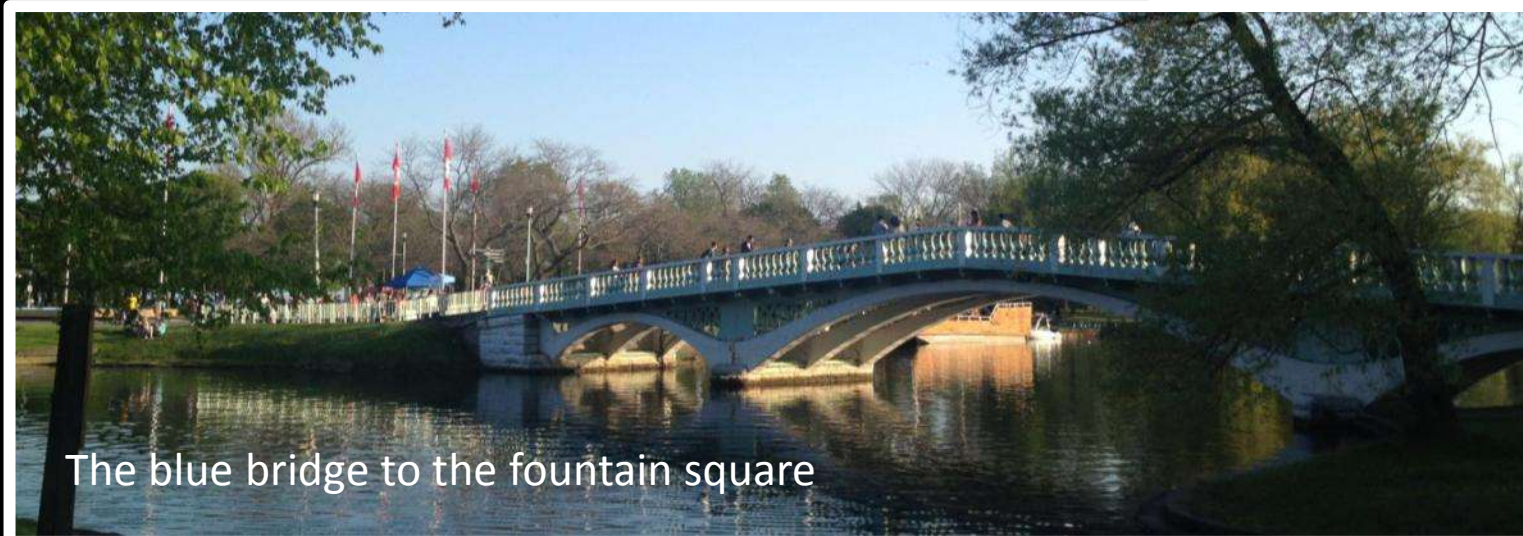

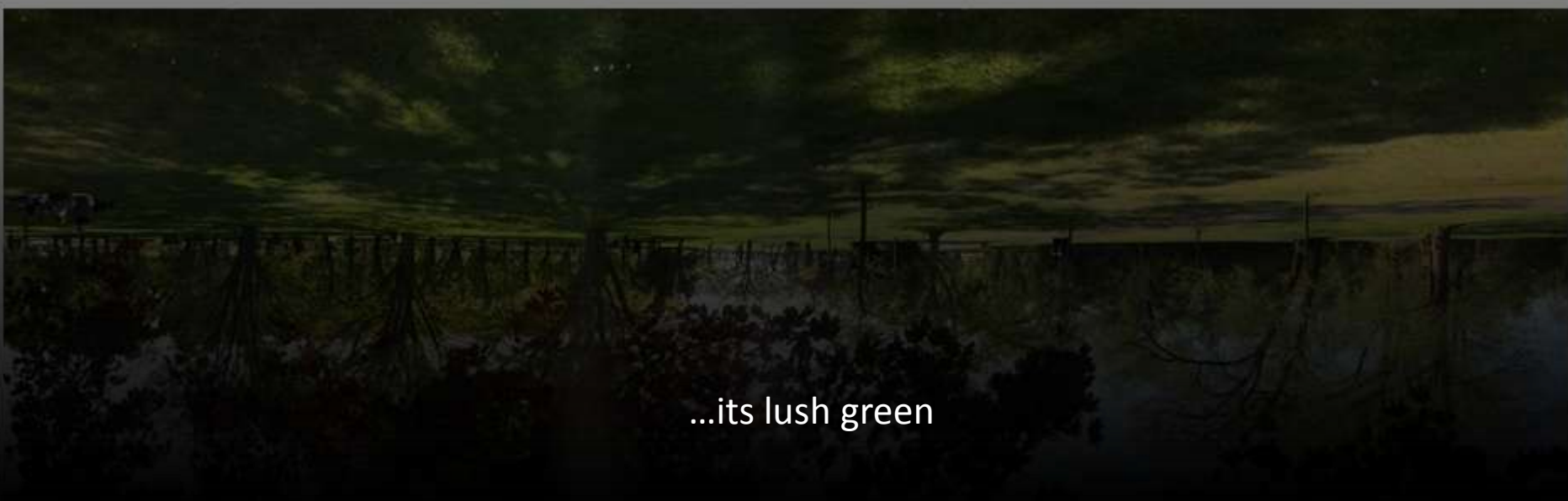

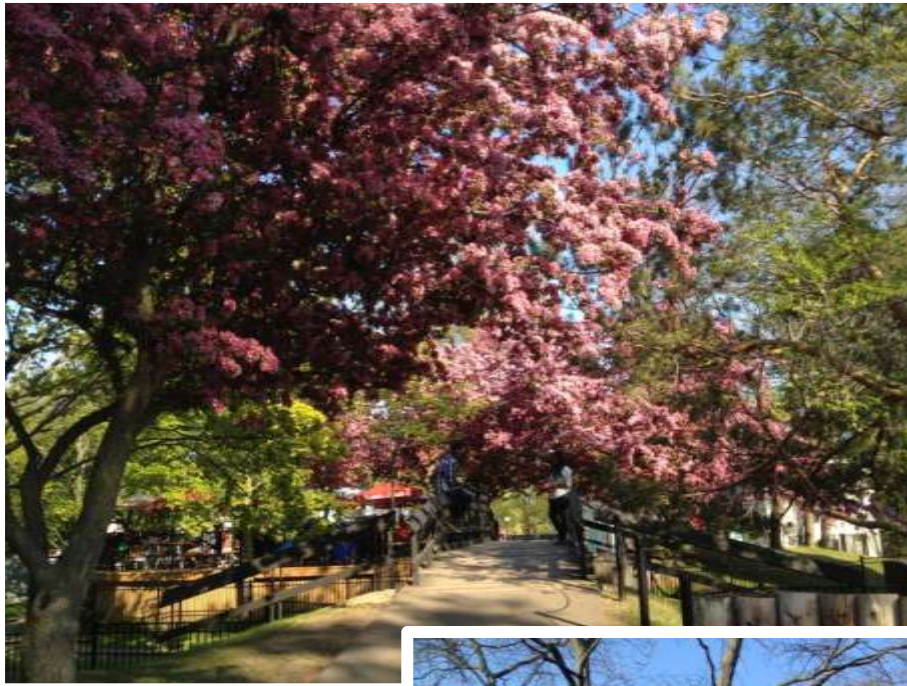


Of course on the island, we have to enjoy the parks
