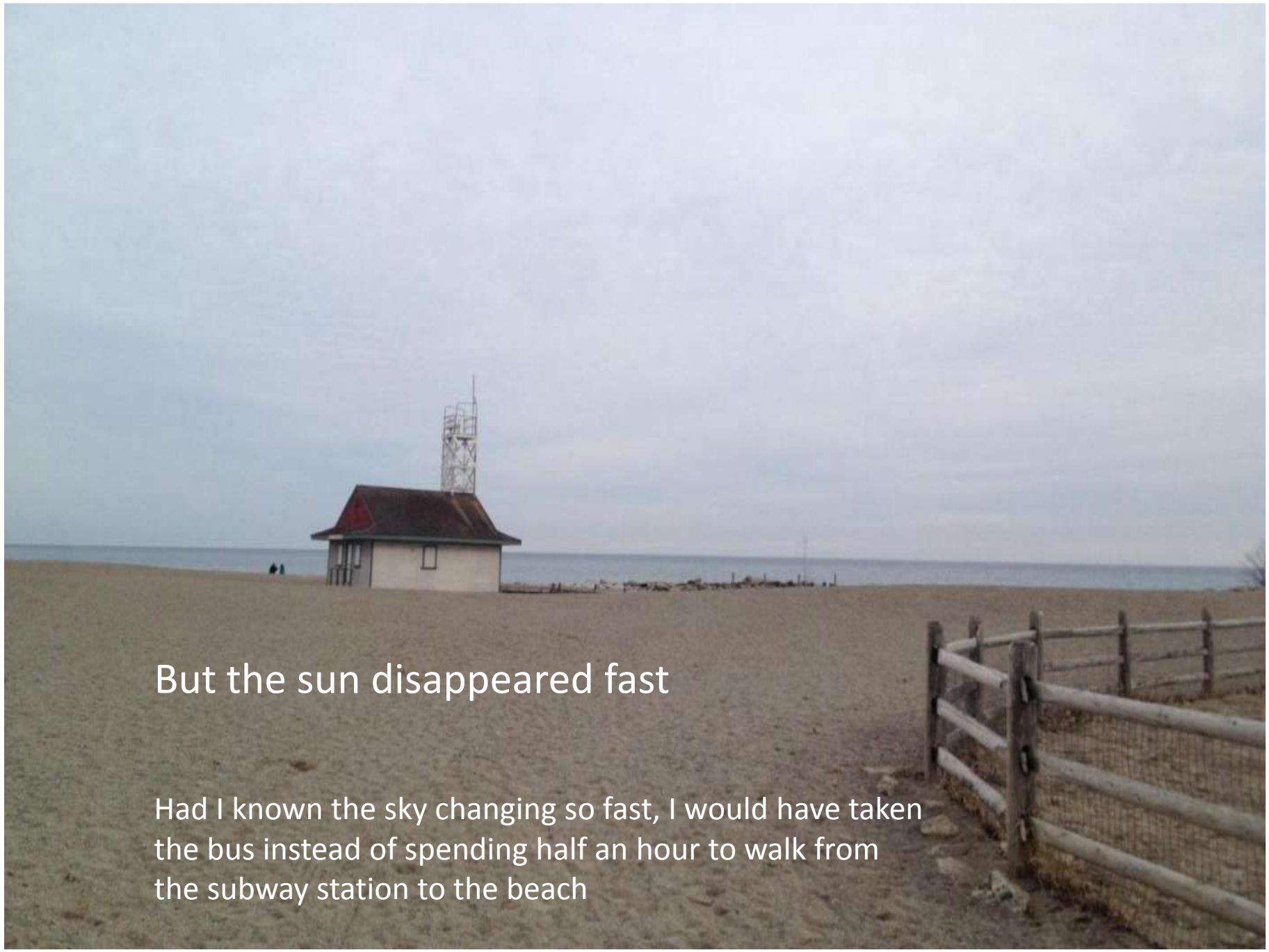
Lots of people out for

Cute creation



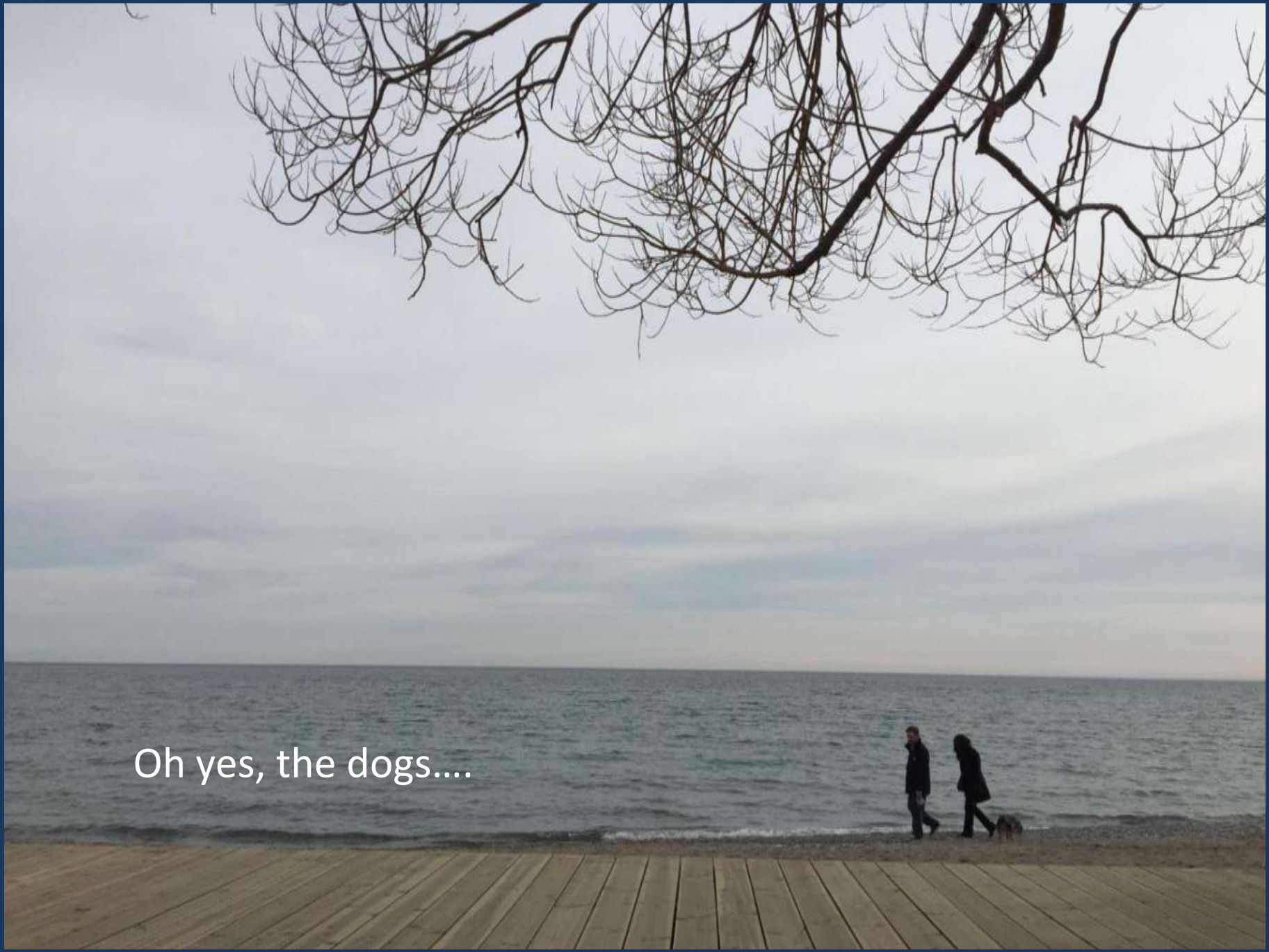


Flying kites. But no blowing of soap bubbles today.
