bicycle riding

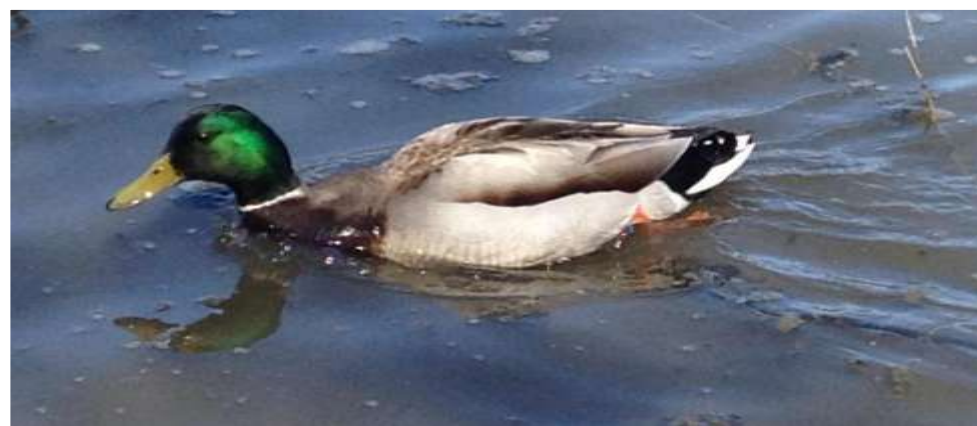


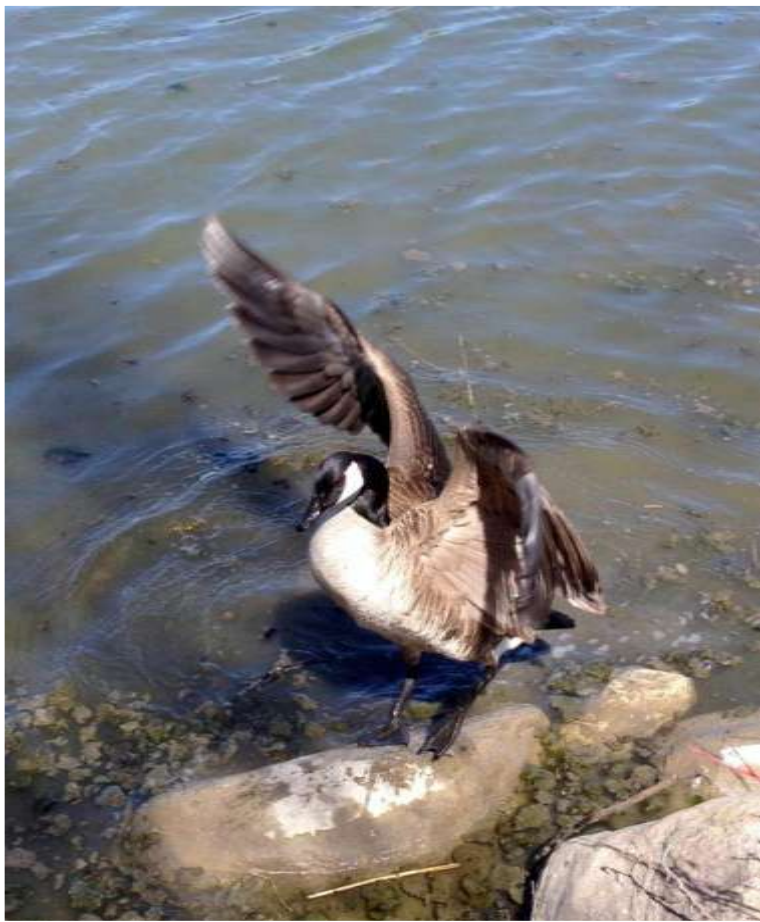


or to laze and chat
